

VEHICLE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

VEHICLES WITH A CURRENT DOD DECAL: Do not need to re-register their vehicle.

VEHICLES WITH EXPIRED DOD DECAL: Arrive at the registration with required documents. Report to the desk marked "UPDATE DOD DECAL". You will receive a new expiration date and, if needed, a new installation identifier.

VEHICLES REQUIRING DOD DECALS: Arrive at the registration with all required documents. Report to any of the registration desks. The documents will be reviewed and installation decal will be issued.

REQUIREMENTS:

Government Identification Card

Valid drivers license, with motorcycle endorsement if applicable

Valid vehicle registration

Proof of Insurance- this must be the card you carry in the vehicle.

Proof of safety inspection- you **MUST** have a valid safety inspection. This can be either from the state your vehicle is registered in or a Virginia safety inspection. If you do not have a safety inspection you will not be able to register your vehicle.

CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES WITHOUT GOVERNMENT IDENTIFICATION: A letter verifying employment and signed by the director of the organization combined with a picture ID will be accepted.

PERSONNEL WITH MULTIPLE VEHICLES: All vehicles can be registered at the same time provided all documents are present and accurate.

PERSONS OTHER THAN THE OWNER REGISTERING THE VEHICLE: Immediate family members can register vehicles, i.e. spouse can register vehicle registered in sponsor's name. For other situations, either a notarized letter or power of attorney from the owner must be presented.

MOTORCYCLES: All motorcycles must have a safety office decal affixed to the motorcycle. Report to the desk marked "MOTORCYCLES" with all required documents. An MP will check your safety decal and issue you the post decal.

VEHICLES WITH A VALID SAFETY INSPECTION BUT WITHOUT DOCUMENTATION: Report to the desk marked "SAFETY INSPECTION VERIFICATION". An MP will go to the vehicle to verify the current inspection, inspect all other documents and issue the installation decal.

MISSING INSURANCE CARD: All vehicles are required to have a valid insurance card to operate the vehicle. If it is missing then the operator can bring the policy or the information desk for assistance.

UNINSURED MOTORIST: Operators who have registered as an uninsured motorist with the state can produce their uninsured motorist card in lieu of the insurance card.

MILITARY OR CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES FROM MILITARY INSTALLATIONS OTHER THAN FT EUSTIS OR FT STORY: Not eligible to register vehicles at Ft Eustis. Exception is for family members of soldiers on overseas PCS.

RETIREES: Eligible to register their vehicles with any DOD facility. During mass registration, retirees can have their vehicles registered during open times.

NATIONAL GUARD AND RESERVISTS: Eligible to register their vehicles at the installation they train at or habitually use for support.

CONTRACTORS: Contractors will either be registered on post or receive a visitor's pass depending on the type and duration of the contract. The military organization employing the contractors needs to contact the Provost Marshal's Office at 878-4554 to get further information.

The operation of a POV on a military installation is a privilege extended by the Installation Commander subject to compliance with appropriate State laws pertaining to financial responsibility, safety inspections and registration; to conditions established in paragraph 2-1, AR 190-5 and AR 190-5-1; and other appropriate regulations. Failure to comply with such laws and regulations may result in an administrative suspension or revocation of driving privileges or termination of installation registration. The registrant must remove the registration decal from the registered vehicle upon termination of employment or sale of the POV.
