SUBJECT: Speeding Enforcement

1. References:

- a. FM 190-5, Military Police Motor Vehicle Traffic Supervision, 1 November 1989.
- b. AR 190-5, Motor Vehicle Traffic Supervision, 7 August 1988.

2. Purpose: To outline post policy regarding speeding enforcement.

3. Responsibilities:

- a. All supervisors will ensure that their personnel aware and fully understand this policy.
- b. The Provost Marshal Office will enforce and track all speeding violations issued on DD Form 1408 or 1805, United States District Court Violation Notices.

4. When a soldier or employee, federal or contractor, receives a violation notice for speeding on post, the activity Executive Officer or Director will receive a letter from the Provost Marshal. The letter will state that a violation notice was issued as a result of the person operating their motor vehicle at a speed in excess of the applicable posted speed limit and will explain that if that same person receives a second violation notice within six months of receiving their first notice, their post driving privileges will be suspended for a period of 30 to 90 days and not to exceed six months.

5. A person receiving a second violation notice within the six-month period will receive a letter from the Deputy Installation Commander, indicating the prescribed period of time the person's post driving privileges are to be suspended.

SUBJECT: Speeding Enforcement

The letter will also indicate the date the suspension is to become effective, normally, ten days from the date of receipt of the letter. The affected person may request an administrative hearing with the Deputy Installation Commander. If suspension is imposed after the hearing, the person has the right to appeal or request reconsideration to the Installation Commander. The affected person may also elect to waive the hearing with the understanding that driving privileges on post are suspended until expiration of the suspension.
